
External Condensation

Its the time of year where you might see condensation forming on the outside of your double or triple-glazed windows.

Don't worry it's completely normal, and just means your energy efficient windows are working as they should.



Liniar

Liniar windows keep the heat inside your home. This means the outer pane of glazing doesn't get warmed as the heat isn't transferred.



Not warming the outer pane means it can drop below the outdoor dew point temperature, causing condensation to form.
